Shaka Zulu

What is it? The venue, which is scheduled to open in June, is a South Africa-themed lounge, restaurant and bar located in Stables Market, Camden. It is being set up at a cost of £5.5m.

What's it got? Corporate organisers will be able to make full use of an impressive 2,500sqm of event space that has been divided across two levels. The venue took six years of planning and is named after King Shaka Zulu—the influential leader of the Zulu Kingdom. The main restaurant will serve a diverse range of cuisine taken from all parts of South Africa and will be able to seat up to 540 guests, while the 300-capacity mezzanine will be more informal with African platters and a Cape Town-inspired fish bar.

Games Lounge

What is it? A new attraction dedicated to the history of video games, located at the National Media Museum in Bradford.

What's it got? Situated in the museum's main foyer, the Games Lounge has been decorated to look like a scene out of a video game and features a display of the early computers and games consoles that turned a nation onto a new pastime. Visitors can play a range of games, from Pac Man to Super Mario Kart, each in their original arcade or console formats. The attraction is available for organisers to hire in the evenings for up to 300 guests.
